JFGI received a grant from the National Center to Encourage Judaism (ncejudaism.org) to support our Taste of Hebrew series, which enables adults to learn how to decode Hebrew in just 6 hours. The course will be held at local synagogues (listed below) and is open to anyone in the community (no synagogue membership needed) for a minimal charge of \$18. Participants will attend four 90-minute classes and receive additional individualized support to help them learn how to read Hebrew for the first time or refresh skills that may be a bit rusty.
