

CONGREGAÇÃO ISRAELITA PAULISTA

Our synagogue, Congregação Israelita Paulista – CIP, is one of the largest in South America with over 1000 families. Like communities everywhere, the Covid-19 pandemic has rapidly undermined the financial stability of our institution. In our 84-year history no other crisis had the negative impact on our community to the extent that this one has. We represent over 4000 individuals or about 5% of the total Jewish community in São Paulo (Brazil is an officially Catholic country with more than 220 million people). We are affiliated with both the reformed and conservative movements and our main goal is to provide a coherent Jewish experience for the entire community while presenting what it means to be Jewish to those outside our community.

A BIT OF CIP'S HISTORY

In 1936 a group of young people gathered around the high holiday to hear a speech by Rabbi Fritz Pinkuss z'l who had recently arrived from Heildelberg, Germany. Perhaps anticipating the Shoah and its impact, the goal was to build a community that would support the cultural and social values of the Jewish people. On our first anniversary, CIP opened Lar das Crianças (Home of the Children), which would become the largest





social project of the congregation. At the time, Lar das Crianças was a type of day-care center meant to help Jewish parents who did not have anyone to look after their children while they were at work.

Today Lar das Crianças sponsors about 400 children who live in vulnerable situations, starting from the age of 4 until their late teens when they are prepared for work and to start a career. Among the many services provided along with cognitive and emotional support are pedagogical work as well as ongoing health care assistance.

Over the years, as a liberal congregation, CIP developed many other projects, such as:
